**LitCovid:** <u>curated literature hub</u> for tracking up-to-date scientific information about COVID-19. It is the most comprehensive resource on the subject, providing a central access a large number of relevant articles in PubMed. The articles are updated daily and are further categorized by different research topics and geographic locations for improved access.

**US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention:** <u>COVID-19 Science Updates</u> providing brief summaries of new COVID-19-related studies on many topics, including epidemiology, clinical treatment and management, laboratory science, and modeling. The summaries are released every Tuesday and Friday.

**VA-ESP COVID19 Reviews:** <u>U.S. Veterans' Affairs (VA) Evidence Synthesis Program</u> - Inventory of living systematic reviews and 'rapid reviews', with a flag for living reviews and for reviews meeting minimum quality standards
